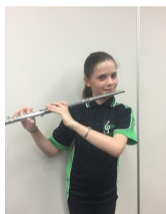

Lismore Performing Arts Festival

Last week LPS was represented in the Lismore Performing Arts Festival by students in the senior choir, the festival concert band and the DET extension band.

On Tuesday night Mrs Berry and Mrs Cole conducted the choir while they performed 'River Song' and 'Puttin' on the Ritz'. Many audience members commented on the high quality of their performance.

The festival concert band comprised of students from six local schools. The students had two rehearsal days earlier in the year before their performances on Tuesday and Wednesday nights as well as the matinee concert on Thursday. Students from Lismore Public played flute, clarinet, saxophone and trumpet and Hamish accompanied the band in the percussion section playing the drums.



On Thursday night Daisy played the flute with the DET extension band. This group of musicians rehearse after school each Thursday at Goonellabah PS to prepare items for various community events. Many of the members are high school students although some adults are required to play to fill in particular sections and Stage 3 students are invited to join once they have reached the required level of proficiency on their chosen instrument. The next extension band performance will be at the LPS Christmas Carols.

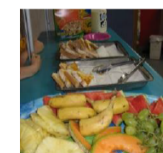
