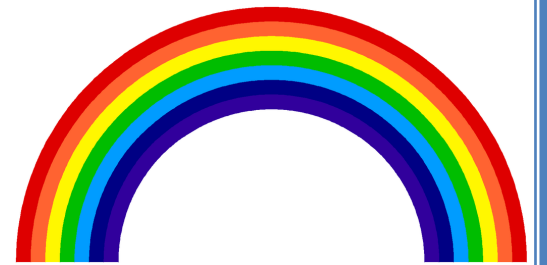
Kindergarten: Blue
