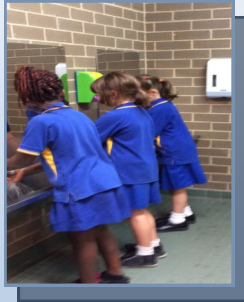

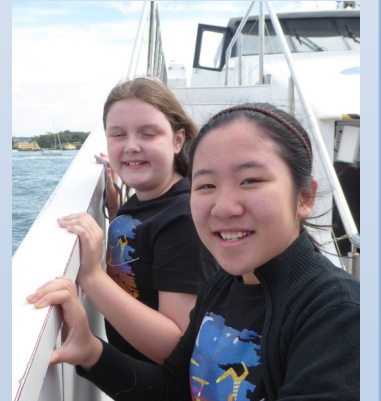

Opera House Senior Choir Performance
