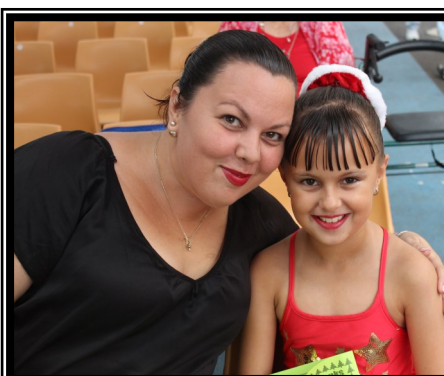

We acknowledge that they are the first peoples of this land on which our school stands.



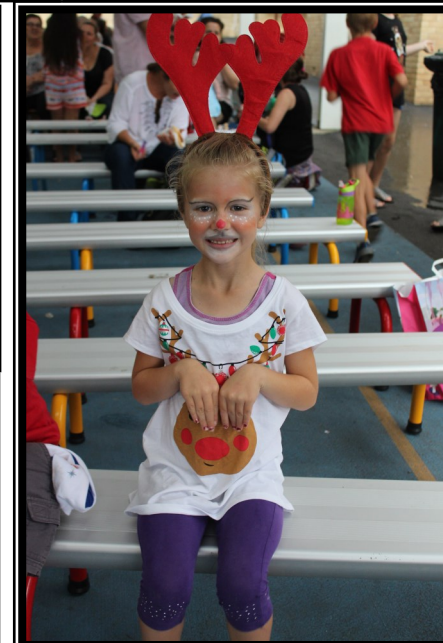
## LPS Christmas Carols
