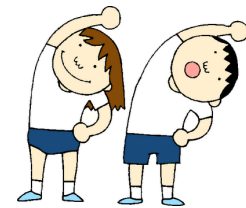

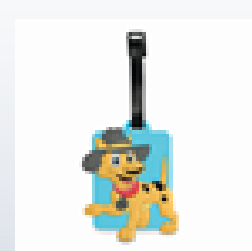
New School Banking rewards now available!
