Movie Night

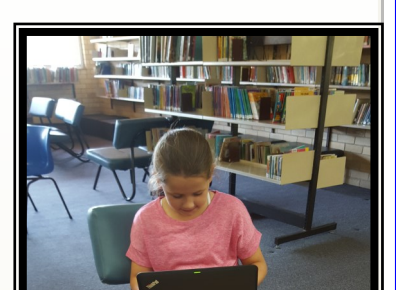
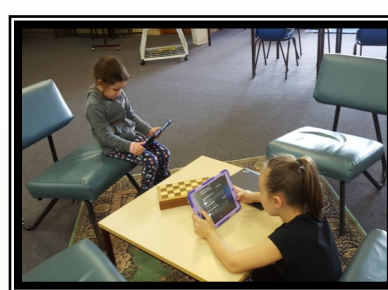
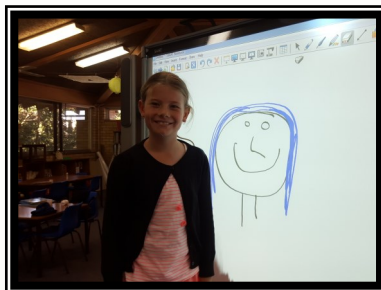
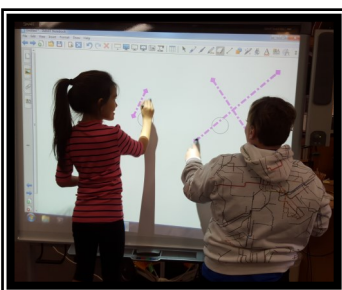

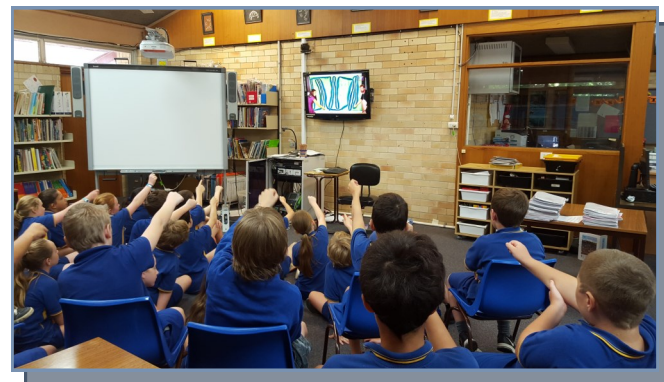
All interviews will be confidential and students who participate will need parental consent.

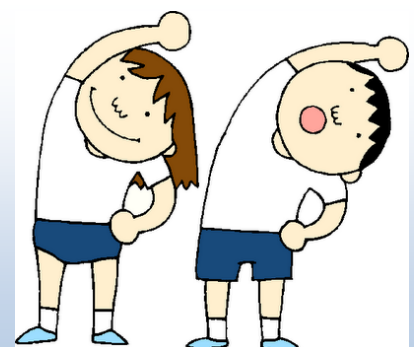
