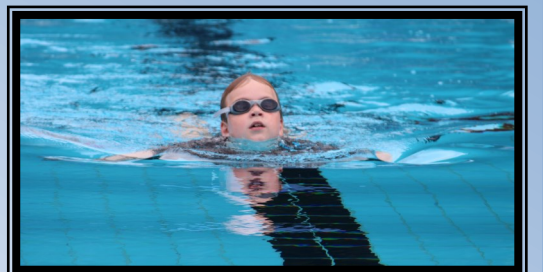
Fete – Saturday 17th September

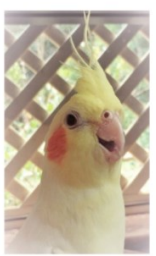
