This wonderful performance used song, dance and drama to give children strategies to bounce back after dealing with bullying, loss and change.

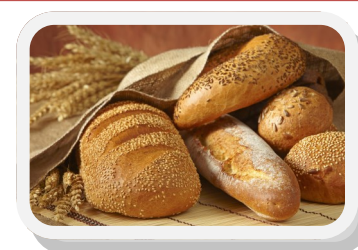
