Welcome to our new families

Our new Kindergarten students commenced 'Big' school last week and have adapted well to their new surroundings. Over the term the Kindy teachers will show the students around the school and get them used to the various routines. The Kindergarten students will not be attending the Friday assembly for a couple of weeks whilst they settle into LPS.

The P&C held an informal afternoon tea for the new Kindy parents and families of LPS. It was great to see a number of parents come along and socialise with the P&C members and some staff. Thank you to the P&C for coordinating this afternoon.

Classes

Classes have settled in nicely and the students are working hard with their learning. At this stage we have 12 mainstream classes, 4 Support classes and a Transition program within our school. Parents and caregivers are encouraged to make contact with their child's teacher if they have any questions or queries. Class teachers will arrange Parent/Teacher interviews later this term to let you know how your child is going and what is planned for their learning.
