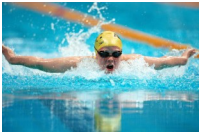

## Principal's Report

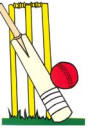
### Northern Rivers Zone Swimming Carnival

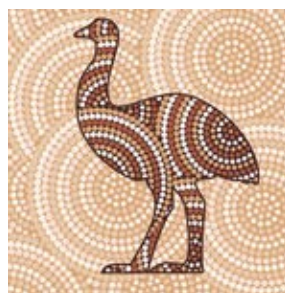

### Bundjalung Language Program

We are very excited to have our Broader Bundjalung Language Program starting next week. The focus of this program is to introduce the language that was originally spoken in this area. Kaleesha King-Rhodes will be our Language Tutor and she will co-teach with Class Teachers to run the program. Initially the program will run in stage 2 and stage 3 for ten weeks and then stage 1 and early stage 1 will be involved.



As part of our Bundjalung Language Program we will be doing a word of the week. If you receive Lismore Highs newsletter you will be aware they also do this and from Week 6 we intend to use the same words. The word of the week is Jingiwallah which means Welcome.

It needs to be noted that Kaleesha will be teaching the Broader Bundjalung Language. We are aware that there are many variations across communities in spelling and pronunciation of words.

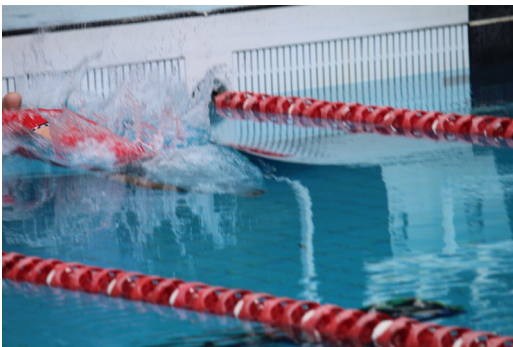
